Fusion Liaison Officer “FLO” Basic Course

COURSE DESCRIPTION: This course is a prerequisite for being a Fusion Liaison Officer (FLO). The course will train students in the information sharing intelligence-gathering mission, which is crucial to the war on terrorism and organized criminal activity.

COURSE OBJECTIVES:

- FLO Certification, description of mission, primary duties and responsibilities.
- Understand the organizational structure of the intelligence community.
- Demonstrate the role/mission of the Idaho Criminal Intelligence Center.
- Explain the proper handling of sensitive information, UNCLASSIFIED//FOR OFFICIAL USE ONLY//LAW ENFORCEMENT SENSITIVE.
- Illustrate domestic and international terrorist groups ideologies and methods of executing terrorist acts.

COURSE LENGTH: 8 Hours

TARGET AUDIENCE/DISCIPLINE: This instruction is designed for patrol, investigative, and jail personnel as well as fire, EMS, emergency management and critical infrastructure security personnel who will be functioning as a FLO for their organization.
