Registration, Log-in, POST Credits

First Time Users - ONE-TIME Registration Required

1. Access the Idaho POST website at www.post.idaho.gov
2. On left side of home page – click on *Distance Learning*
3. Click – *Webinar portal*
4. Click – *Cell Phone Forensics*
5. You will be taken to the Idaho POST log-in page
6. Click on “*create your free-all-access account if you have not previously taken a course.*”
7. Establish your user name and password – fill out remaining information – click on “*create my new account.*”
8. You will then receive an email confirming your new account request. CLICK on THE WEB ADDRESS TO CONFIRM YOUR NEW ACCOUNT,
9. Once account is confirmed – review the Introduction to Online Training FAQ

1. Access the Idaho POST website at www.post.idaho.gov

3. Click – *Webinar portal*
4. Click – *Cell Phone Forensics*
5. Log-in with user name and password (see one-time registration above)
6. Read the pop-up disclaimer, then click OK
7. You will be taken to the on-line training portal – click on Cell Phone Forensics Training Courses
8. Click on webinar category of choice
9. Click on archived webinar session of choice
