

Practical Application of the **FORENSIC EXPERIENTIAL TRAUMA INTERVIEW** within the Sexual Assault Investigation Response

Attendees will apply and demonstrate FETI skill sets learned during the Introduction to the Forensic Experiential Trauma Interview course (March 7 - 8, 2016 at Ada County SO). Examples of forensic experiential trauma interviews will be utilized to demonstrate the correct practical application of the technique. It is essential for those who interview victims of trauma to experience what it is like to be interviewed about a traumatic event.



Instruction and Practical Application will include:

- **Overview of Introductory Course Information**
- **Demonstrating Genuine Empathy** (Practical Exercise)
- **The First 5 Minutes** (Group Interview)
- **Using Sensory Questions** (Group Exercise)
- **Using FETI Questions** (Group Interview)
- **Documenting FETI** (Practical Exercise)
- **Interviewee Experience** (Individual Trauma Interview)
- **Class Critique of all Interviews facilitated by instructors**

This training is fundamental for any professional who interviews trauma victims.

Attendees will be expected to perform the role of interviewee sharing personal experiences of stress and trauma. Attendees will be required to experience and practice actual FETI interviews in front of the class who will offer critique facilitated by instructors. Attendees are required to be present for all instruction in order to obtain a certificate of completion. This course is limited to 30 participants, is intended only for professional audiences and has a prerequisite requirement of successfully completing the Introduction to the Forensic Experiential Trauma Interview within the Sexual Assault Investigative Response course.
