Mrs. Anthony provides training and community awareness for Human Trafficking and has helped launch specialized trainings to schools, medical staff, military, community agencies and other professionals. Mrs. Anthony has been recognized with a Pillar of Strength award by her agency in 2012 and a community award as a Woman of Distinction in 2014 for her work in Human Trafficking.
