The Commercial Motor Vehicle Interdiction Techniques Course is an 8-hour class that will explore commercial motor vehicle (CMV) interdiction techniques, documents relating to criminal activity, movement of bulk currency via CMVs, common hiding areas and concealment techniques, truck stops, evaluating external truck markings, evaluating vehicle documents and log books, recognizing truck modifications and common indicators.

There is no cost to attend this course. Travel expenses, lodging and meals are the responsibility of the attendee.

The course will take place on January 24, 2013 from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at the Spokane County Sheriff's Training Center, 10319 E. Appleway Blvd in Spokane Valley, Washington.
